What experience did Jesus have on the mountain? What did the disciples appreciate? They realized that Jesus was very close to the Father. To try to explain this, the gospels say that their clothes reflected an indescribable whiteness. They realize that God reveals himself in Jesus, in a similar way to how he revealed himself to Moses and Elijah; that Jesus is part of the cloud of divinity. The disciples have been able to prove this experience from the humanity of Jesus; a humanity like ours: limited, weak, expires. As Lay Claretians we are called to come frequently to this Jesus who reveals us to the Father to make of Him and his Kingdom the only absolute of our life (Sourcebook 31)
